## Wooden ring with wooden balls and dried flowers

**Instructions No. 2435** 

Difficulty: Beginner

Working time: 3 Hours

Create a stylish **wall decoration** with **dried flowers**. You'll be right on trend. You can change the ring again and again depending on the season and change the flowers as desired.



## Simply stylishly crafted:

- 1. Cut two, approx. 1 metre long ribbons from the warp yarn and knot the ends together. Do not knot the ribbons directly at the top, but leave some space.
- 2. Take the first **wooden ball**. Thread one ribbon from above and one ribbon from below through the ball and then knot them behind the ball. Proceed in this way with the other wooden balls until the desired length is reached. Now knot the strand with the wooden balls to the wooden ring.
- 3. Turn the wooden balls so that the opening points up and down. If necessary, fix the balls with **hot glue**.
- 4. Push the **dried flowers** through the wooden balls as desired.
